The Way; Home Handbook

Rules and Regulations

Staff

- 1. I will address all staff members with proper respect.
- 2. I will not abuse (physically or verbally) any Staff member.
- 3. I will not threaten any staff member.
- 4. I will submit to the staff's authority and will not be disobedient.
- 5. I will not be defiant or rebellious.
- 6. I will be respectful to all staff with my words and my actions.

Rooms

- 1. I will keep my room clean at all times. I will put my personal belongings away every day, including weekends. A checklist will be followed for all room cleanings.
- 2. I will make my bed at wake-up and keep it that way.
- 3. Only one mattress per bed.
- 4. No making of "curtains" to conceal bottom bunk.
- 5. No nails, tacks, stickers, or writing on walls, beds, or furniture.

Dress

- 1. I will dress appropriately when leaving campus for church or any other activity.
- 2. I understand that the staff may require the changing of any clothing considered inappropriate.
- 3. I will not wear any type of body piercings.
- 4. No clothing that promotes drugs, alcohol, nicotine products, satanic behavior, etc.

Personal Conduct

- 1. I will not fight physically or verbally.
- 2. I will not threaten other clients.
- 3. I will not use drugs, alcohol, or have products of that kind in my possession at any time.
- 4. I understand that dietary supplements will be restricted to multivitamins dispensed during med. call unless approved by staff.
- 5. I will not curse or use off-color language or gestures.
- 6. I will not talk about street life, drugs, or past sinful behavior.
- 7. I will not engage in horseplay.
- 8. I understand that I am subject to random testing for alcohol and drugs by a wide variety of means including urine screens, Breathalyzer, and other methods.
- 9. I will not use someone else's property without their consent.
- 10. I will take a shower daily (before 9:00PM)
- 11. I understand that I am only allowed in the dorm room to which I am assigned.

Music and Video

- 1. I will not play or listen to any explicit music or music deemed inappropriate by staff on any instrument, nor will I sing or rehearse the lyrics to any such music.
- 2. Original CD's displaying artist name and music content only. (No burned copies).
- 3. All CD's must be approved by staff.
- 4. No digital storage music players allowed.

- 5. No devices capable of storing or playing digital media allowed. (cameras, video players, tablets, etc.).
- 6. No personal televisions allowed.
- 7. All movies must be approved by staff. (PG-13 or less).
- 8. No radios will be allowed in transport to, from, or during work or church.
- 9. Christian music only will be played in The Way vehicles.
- 10. I will not have a cell phone in my possession or use any cell phone unless Program Director is supervising.

Kitchen

- 1. I understand that the kitchen will be off limits except for those performing assigned tasks or daily chores.
- 2. I will eat all meals at the specified time. (Tardiness will not be tolerated).

Laundry

- 1. Clothing will be washed once a week on a designated day.
- 2. Laundry day scheduled will be posted near the laundry room.
- 3. Only the assigned Client or staff may use the laundry room appliances.
- 4. Your laundry box/ basket must have your name on it to have your clothes laundered.

Phone

- 1. I understand that I am not allowed personal phone calls during my first 30 days in the program.
- 2. I will agree to one, ten-minute phone call per week; incoming or outgoing, which must be registered and approved by a staff member.
- 3. If I am married or have children, I may make or receive an additional ten-minute call per week to my spouse or children.
- 4. The staff member will dial the phone and ask for person whom I am calling.
- 5. I understand all calls will be on speaker phone.
- 6. All calls will be made from the office at designated times.
- 7. I understand that I may not possess a cell phone.
- 8. No phone calls on the weekends.

Correspondence

- 1. I will not correspond with a married member of the opposite sex other than family members.
- 2. Married residents will not be allowed to correspond with someone of the opposite sex other than family members.
- 3. I understand that all written correspondence must go through USPS and is subject to inspection by staff prior to mailing or receiving.
- 4. Student will not be allowed to correspond with incarcerated individuals outside of their immediate family.

Campus Visits

- 1. Visitation is Saturday from 12:00 PM to 3:00 PM. Other arrangements for visitation will be made if working on visitation day.
- 2. All visitors will be screened on visitation day.
- 3. Administration may cancel visitation if The Way; Home's schedules require it. It will be the responsibility of visitors to inquire if visitation has been canceled.
- 4. Visitation will be for immediate family only. All other visitors will be approved by the administration office, on an individual basis.
- 5. All prepared food coming on The Way; Home's property must be inspected and approved by Staff prior to contact with Clients.
- 6. Visitors must furnish staff with proper identification when requested.
- 7. Visitors must LEAVE CELL PHONES IN VEHICLES. No cell phones allowed during visitation.
- 8. Visitors are subject to search.
- 9. Any items not inspected by Staff will be considered contraband.
- 10. No visitor will be allowed, who is prohibited by court order.
- 11. All visitors must park in designated area.
- 12. Clients may not go to the designated parking area.
- 13. Once a visitor leaves campus they may not return on the same day.

Off-Campus Passes

- 1. No overnight passes.
- 2. All off campus passes will be for Saturday for 8:00 AM until 8:00 PM.
- 3. Pass requests must be filled out no later than one week prior to pass.
- 4. Clients must have completed Step 4/Principle 4 before eligible for a pass. There will be 28 days between each pass.

Money

- 1. I will not receive money directly from anyone while in The Way; Home program.
- 2. I understand that all money I bring or acquire while in the program will be deposited into my client account, administered by The Way; Home.
- 3. I understand that The Way; Home must handle all money and I am responsible for all expenses (ex. Medications, Dentist/ Doctor visits, etc.) and expenses will be deducted from my client account.
- 4. I understand that as part of The Way; Home program I will be required to work on or off campus to offset program costs and **build discipline**. Program expenses will be documented and deducted from funds earned while I am a client. I understand that I will not be held liable for any shortfalls between money earned and program costs during my stay. I will be solely responsible for expenses incurred not associated with the program (ex. medical dental, or personal).

General

- 1. I will not leave campus without the permission of a staff member.
- 2. I understand that if I lend anything out, it is possible that I may not get it back.
- 3. I will not use any tools without staff permission. Any tools that are used will be your responsibility; you are responsible to see that they are properly cleaned and returned the same day that they were used.

- 4. I will perform listed daily duties at the specified time and other duties as requested by a staff member.
- 5. I will participate in all scheduled activities including but not limited to class, chapel, church, work and Celebrate Recovery.
- 6. I will be punctual. Tardiness will result in discipline.
- 7. I will be inside the dorm by dark unless I am at a scheduled activity.
- 8. I will not walk beyond the perimeters of The Way; Home property.
- 9. I understand that if I deface or destroy any of The Way; Home's property or commit any physical violence, I will be dismissed from the program and will owe The Way; Home for all damages.
- 10. Un-biblical sexual relationships or promiscuous behavior will not be permitted.
- 11. I will not walk into a restricted area without first knocking and waiting to enter until invited to do so.
- 12. If I get sick or hurt, I will report to the Supervisor on duty. If it is determined that I am unable to work my regular scheduled Job, I will be assigned to a designated area.
- 13. Any person wanting to leave the program must notify a staff member and have his personal belongings and his person searched before leaving the property.
- 14. The Way; Home will not be responsible for items left behind. If you leave the program, no monies will be given from the Client account.
- 15. No aerosol cans of any type will be permitted.
- 16. No pets allow

Discipline

- 1. I understand that when I have done something disrespectful or unruly the witnessing staff member will discipline me.
- 2. I also understand that a staff member will fill out a discipline report to be submitted to the Disciplinary Team.
- 3. The Disciplinary Team will strive to meet weekly, and all discipline notices will be dealt with at that time.
- 4. All discipline must be completed and filed prior to my graduation date.

Church

- 1. Family members may sit with me if they wish. There may be occasion that I will be assigned a seat.
- 2. I will stay in my seat (unless I am at the altar or have a medical need) until the service has been dismissed by a pastor.
- 3. I will bring my Bible to church.
- 4. I will wear appropriate clothing (No shorts, sandals, hats or anything deemed inappropriate by staff).
- 5. I will be prepared to leave for church approximately one hour before the service is to begin.
- 6. I will pick up any trash from the section where I am seated before leaving church.
- 7. I will not talk during service.
- 8. I will not go outside during service or go to any vehicles.
- 9. I will not loiter in the parking lot before or after church.
- 10. No public display of affection.

- 11. Do not ask any church patron to handle any business for you.
- 12. Be reverent to God. (Stand when asked, do not write notes, doodle, etc.).

Celebrate Recovery

- 1. I will attend all meetings, including Celebration Sunday School class.
- 2. I will adhere to all small group guidelines.
- 3. I will have at least completed Step 4/Principle 4 before graduating from The Way; Home.
